

HNCA Ambassador Criteria

To be considered for the HNCA Ambassador Program, you must:

- Be diagnosed and treated for an oral, head and neck cancer, and/or be a caregiver for a family member, loved one, or friend facing treatment(s) for a head and neck cancer.
- Be 21 years or older.
- Be available for a minimum of 1-2 HNCA requested appearances, per calendar year.
- Be approved by the HNCA Board.
- Be willing to travel to speak on behalf of the Head and Neck Cancer Alliance as one of its Ambassadors. Expenses will be paid by company and/or organization requesting Ambassador.
- Agree that Ambassador role is voluntary and provide consent to HNCA to share your personal cancer journey along with images/videos provided to HNCA.
- Represent HNCA and its mission in a professional manner.
- Be willing to present to large as well as small groups and represent HNCA as an Ambassador.
- Complete ALL requested online forms and provide a 6-8 paragraph profile summary of your individual cancer experience.
- Work with HNCA staff on presentations to ensure HNCA is fully represented in all agreed upon appearances.
- Review necessary educational materials provided by HNCA that will aid in Ambassador's understanding of topics that may be posed in interviews and/or speaking engagements.
- Understand that HNCA works each day to educate all on head and neck cancer and that appearances, story, and quotes may appear on the HNCA website, shared on social media, and in HNCA-related educational materials.
- Agree that the Ambassador volunteer position can be discontinued at any time by either party.
