A white or red patch on the gums, the tongue, or the lining of the mouth



Lump or a sore in the mouth, throat or neck that does not heal



Pain in the mouth, neck, throat, upper teeth, face, or chin that does not go away



Sinuses that are blocked and do not clear, or chronic sinus infections that do not respond to treatment with antibiotics

- Bleeding through the nose
- Unusual bleeding in the mouth



- Change or hoarseness in the voice
- Trouble breathing or speaking

Pain or ringing in the ears, or trouble hearing



 A sore throat that does not go away • Difficulty or pain when swallowing



Numbness or paralysis of the muscles in the face



Swelling or other trouble with the eyes



Frequent headaches



Swelling of the jaw
